<u>Approval of February's minutes:</u> Cynthia motioned to approve minutes with minor modifications to music instrument requests; seconded by Wendy. Minutes approved.

Principal Report: Mireille Filion & Lysanne Darmody

From Mireille-

- Continue to have more registrations; about 560 enrolments, currently.
- Projected numbers for next year sent to the board.
- Blues in the School last week 4 concerts and some grades 7/8 practiced every day with the musicians. Will invite parents of those students for a little concert.
- Dance workshop pushed to the end of March
- March 22-24 Jamal the Poet
- Field trips for winter: had looked at skiing for Feb/March but Vorlage was not able to accommodate. Booked some days for next year.
- 4 basketball teams practicing (int & jr boys/girls) Jr will be intramural no tournament at this time
- Hot Chocolate House talent show grades 3-6. Show during the day and one for parents near end of March
- Mr. Elliot's poetry night will be in the spring for 7/8s
- Graduation pictures done last Friday
- Yearbook is being worked on by Mme Rousell
- June 27 tentative for graduation

- Math and literacy Tutoring program ends March 31
- Received school clothing order. Website is still active and can continue ordering throughout the year. Will keep it open for next year. Happy with quality.
- Received letter from city council trying to support the parking/traffic situation. School has sent many reminders to parents and will continue to do so. Bus loop is very busy.
 School is doing what they can. Will send home a paper flyer after the March break. Staff will discuss some possible solutions to alleviate congestion and direct parents to other areas to park.

Chair Report: Cynthia Allen

- We were awarded a Pro Grant for the topic of with food sovereignty. Heard from Growing Up Organic – they have never done a school but thought it was a great idea and are looking into putting together this program. Looked into cost of seed starting kits. Idea is to have an evening with students/parents to learn from this presentation, and plant their kit to take home. Suggested date of Thursday, April 27.
- Looked to invite new school trustee but the COW meeting happens the same day as ours. Perhaps May or June since our meetings won't align.

Fundraising/Activities & Communications: Wendy Lim

- Pizza day registration for next term opened this week
- Sales are great. Approx. 50 pizzas are ordered weekly this year which is about 10 more than pre-pandemic.

Family Fun Day:

- Held a first committee meeting: firetruck and Circus Delights confirmed. There are some games already in the storage shed

Financial Summary: Jennifer Tracey

- Only change is what we committed to spend last month. Commitment to Circus Delights is in but will sell tickets for the day so that will offset the cost.
- Have been able to support the school much more this year than the last couple due to limited revenue (couldn't have pizza days, other fundraisers, etc.)
- Parent Involvement Committee \$500 cheque is being sent directly to the school

<u>Wish List:</u>

- Nothing this month.

Round Table:

- Cynthia: Has someone spoken to Mrs. Dunn about family fun day? A: Yes, she knows and will plan the book fair for then.
- Wendy: Went to a board meeting of creating an atmosphere of belonging at school council and they touched on how to bring people into councils. Thinking of having a sort of Open House: Instead of a meeting, have light refreshments, informal meet and greet. Cynthia: Have tried this in the past; had the idea of parent representatives of different grades/levels; always have booths at Family Fun Day, parent-teacher night, Kindergarten info night.
- Pamela: What about a survey on what people are looking for from their council?
- Kelly offered to talk about council during the Kinder play at the park
- Can work on informing parents that they don't have to join council to participate; can attend meetings without formally joining.
- Will talk about a council open house (next year?) and little signs advertising Family Fun Day hosted by Council.
- First meeting of the year could be elections/drop in.
