#### **Dance-a-thon** – Tracy

- The dance a thon as a whole was \$6041.00 in revenue, this means that in the last 6 months there has been over \$18,000.00 raised. Thank you to all who worked hard to bring this all together, it was a lot of planning and it went over well.
- Some feedback has come in about the timing of the dance-a-thon, that there is a lot of money coming into the school for milk, pizza, sports etc..., we think that Feb/March would be a better time of year next year.
- What could we do to inspire the older grades to get more involved and donate? The younger classes really participate well and we will learn from that.
- We will also post and house recommendations and documents in our school council gmail site, we will work with Rosita to collect that information. We will make a depository of Council documents.
- Next time around, we have to be specific as to what the funds raised will be going towards.
- Next year we will also pre-order the glow bracelets for the 1<sup>st</sup> group that is in the dance. This is really
  for the Kindergarten kids they need help with putting them on as well as the money can be collected
  the day before.
- We will also contact different schools to see what the best practice for money collection is. This is not as easy from an organizational stand point and took a lot of time to organize.
- A lot of great feedback from the music and the requests that came in advance. In addition, the dance instructors were also very helpful and well received
- We will also work with Rosita to send a close out email, we will need to identify the exact place that the
  money will be going first. An email will be sent to parents once the divisions have identified what will be
  purchased with the funds.

#### **Principal Report** – Nicole Guertin-Colverson

- SLP school learning plan
  - A hyper focus on Math, specifically around mindset, is a theme for the year. This was a theme
    that was discussed last meeting. The thought behind that is if we can change the mindset of the
    children as it relates to math, they will be more open to learning and enjoy it more. The Boards
    goal is around Math and wellness, this will tie in nicely

- We will be launching math buddies (younger- older grades) partner together, booster groups and the SLT will be putting together problems of the month and post them within the hallways where students can work together in the hallways.
- There will also be a letter going home, with specific suggestions as to how parents can support the growth in Math.
- We are also going to be doing Scientist in the School. This will be focused on math for kid's grades 2-8.
- There are also video's on mind-set and some of these will be sent home throughout the year.

#### Garden work

 All of the picnic tables are in and have been installed. The buddy benches were also installed today. The idea is to have older kids within the school to get involved and get the kids who are feeling like they need a bit of extra friends.

#### Stage Curtain

- November 24<sup>th</sup>, 2016 there is a family math evening at the school to be facilitated by Jump 2 Math. There will be a note going out to the parents within the school. There will be a sign up list between 6-8pm.

#### Wish list-

- Scientist in the School for all grades 2-8 students. This will cost ~\$3500.00, there will be a total of 17 classes participating. This was already approved last month during council.
- New flash cards 10 sets of addition and 10 sets of subtraction. They will need a total of 20 packs for each of the 9 primary classes. There will be 180 sets of cards purchased for a cost of up to \$300.00 in total.
- Council will be giving a total of \$10,000. Approximately \$4000 for the SiS and the math flash cards.
  The remaining \$6000 will be used to purchase electronics/technology and other supplies. Each division
  will be allotted funds based on the number of students per division. We will share what was purchased
  in a letter going home about the dance-a-thon and what the proceeds were used for. Council vote was
  unanimous All in favor.
